#### US Embassy, New Delhi Gardens Provided Advanced Trainings in IHT

The U.S. Embassy in New Delhi is one of the largest U.S. diplomatic missions in the world, a reflection of the importance the United States places on its relationship with India. The Embassy represents 17 U.S. federal government agencies, from the U.S. Department of State to the Federal Aviation Administration.

Institute of Horticulture Technology conducted the advanced training programme for the gardeners deputed by U.S. Embassy New Delhi for up skilling them in modern gardening practices through capacity building program. Interactive lectures, hands on training and demonstration on/for soil solarization, type of bed preparation, plug nursery in solilless media, gardens and their management, modern gardening practices, Importance of soil nutrition soil and its management, ornamental planting material production, protected structures with climate control, micro-irrigation with fertigation technology, weed management and insect-pest management was provided to the gardeners. Gardeners were also visited a modern garden nursery in which a wide collection of more than 200 species of annual flowers, house plants, shrubs, trees, creepers, bonsai, ferns, fruits, vegetables and medicinal plants, etc. was there.

environment, nutrient recipes, water quality analysis, plant nutrition management, greenhouse technology- climate control, production technologies for various crops, training and pruning, hydroponic greenhouse pest management etc.
